



MUSTO PERFORMANCE SKIFF NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

NOTICE OF RACE

DATE: 20-22 November 2015
VENUE: Port Melbourne Yacht Club

The Organising Authority invites entries to the 2016 Musto Performance Skiff Australian Championship (the Championships). The Championships will be conducted by the Port Melbourne Yacht Club Inc, on behalf of the Australian Musto Performance Skiff Class Association.

The Organising Authority is Port Melbourne Yacht Club Inc.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The Championships will be governed by The *Rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)* and the *Special Regulations of Yachting Australia (YA)*.
- 1.2 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising will be in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display Event sponsor's name(s)/logo(s) and bow numbers. If required, the Organising Authority will supply these items and they shall be affixed and/or worn as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.3 The Organising Authority reserves the right to refuse advertising by a boat or competitor when it is in conflict with the laws of the Victorian and or Australian governments.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The Championships are open to all boats of the Musto Performance Skiff Class that meet with the requirements of the Class Rules.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached Entry Form and emailing it to Marcus Hamilton on marcushamilton247@gmail.com.

4. FEES

- 4.1 The Entry Fee will be AUD\$150 (including GST) if submitted and paid by 18th November 2015. Late Entries will incur an additional \$50.

Registration and entry fees can only be made by direct debit to Australian Musto Performance Skiff Class Association.

Entries will not be valid until full payment is received.

5. SCHEDULE

5.1 Australian Championships

The regatta schedule has been structured to maximise flexibility and support a diversity of conditions, based around:

- 2 sessions per day
- Maximum 3 races per session
- Maximum 4 races per day
- The maximum number of races for the Championships will be nine.
- On the last day of the Championships no warning signal will be made after 1500hrs
- Race Officer discretion on when to sail the fleet, supported by input from an AMPSA representative

6. MEASUREMENT

- 6.1 The Race Committee may weigh, measure or inspect any boat and or her equipment and sails before, during or after the races.
- 6.2 Registration of sails and limitation stamping for the Championships will take place prior to the first race.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions for the Championships will be available by 16 November 2015 from on the AMPSA website or at Registration.

8. VENUE

The racing will be held on the waters of Port Phillip Bay in the vicinity of Port Melbourne.

9. THE COURSES

The course to be sailed will be a windward-leeward configuration.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11. SCORING

- 11.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply as modified below.
- 11.2 A minimum of 4 races are required to be completed to constitute a series. In addition,
- (a) When 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores;
 - (b) When from 5 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score;
 - (c) When 8 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12. BUOYANCY

All competitors shall wear, while afloat, an approved personal flotation device which is in good condition and is in accordance with the specifications issued or approved by the competitor's national authority affiliated to the International Sailing Federation, or a standards organisation, or certification authority, recognised for the purpose by its respective government. Attention is drawn to RRS Fundamental Rule 1.2.

13. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats, such as coach boats etc, must be registered with the Organising Authority and shall be identified as required by the Organising Authority.

Support boats must carry a VHF radio capable of operating on channels 71 and 73.

14. LAUNCHING AND BERTHING

Launching will be from the foreshore Port Melbourne.

Conditions of Entry

I acknowledge and agree that:

1. In this Event application and declaration: "**Club**" means and includes: Port Melbourne Yacht Club Inc and its directors, officers, members, servants or agents. "**Claim**" means and includes any action, proceeding, claim, demand, damage or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence **but does not include** a claim in respect of any action, suit etc made by any person entitled to compensation under a relevant Club insurance policy or under any right expressly conferred by the Club constitution.
2. **If accepted I will be permitted** to participate in the Event subject to my complying with the terms and conditions of the Event, this declaration and any reasonable direction issued by the Event Organisers or their representatives.
3. **The Event rules & this declaration** comprise a contract between me and the Club and are necessary and reasonable to promote and conduct the Event. I also agree to abide by the rules and policies of Yachting Australia (copies of which are available from Yachting Australia), and be subject to the jurisdiction of Yachting Australia in relation to the application and enforcement of such rules and policies. I agree to be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing and by all other rules that govern the event and I acknowledge that rule 4 – Decision to Race – places the sole responsibility for deciding whether or not to start or continue racing on the boat.
4. **Warning:** Participation in the Event can be inherently dangerous. I acknowledge that I am exposed to certain risks during my participation in the Event including, but not limited to, physical exertion and injury, bodily contact, falls, equipment failure and unpredictable weather conditions. I acknowledge that accidents can and often do happen which may result in me being injured or even killed, or my property being damaged. I have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.
5. **WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999**
Under the provisions of the **Fair Trading Act 1999** several conditions are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. These conditions mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you are:
 - rendered with due care and skill; and
 - as fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances; and
 - reasonably fit for any particular purpose or might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.Under section 32N of the **Fair Trading Act 1999**, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the **Fair Trading Act 1999** if you are killed or injured because the services were not rendered with due care and skill or they were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.
NOTE: The change to your rights, as set out in this form, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part. "Gross negligence" is defined in the Fair Trading (Recreational Services) Regulations 2004.
For the purposes of this clause 5, "the Supplier" shall mean and include the Club.
6. **Exclusion of Implied Terms:** I acknowledge that where I am a consumer of recreational services, as defined by any relevant law, certain terms and rights usually implied into a contract for the supply of goods or services may be excluded. I acknowledge that these implied terms and rights and any liability of the Club flowing from them, are expressly excluded to the extent possible by law, by this Event application declaration. To the extent of any liability arising, the liability of the Club will, at its discretion be limited to the re-supply of the services or payment of the cost of having the services supplied again.
7. **Release and Indemnity:** In consideration of the Club accepting my application for entry to the Event I, to the full extent permitted by law:
 - (a) release and will release the Club from all Claims that I may have or may have had but for this release arising from or in connection with my participation in the Event; and
 - (b) indemnify and will keep indemnified the Club in respect of any Claim by any person including but not only another participant in the Event arising as a result of or in connection with my participation in the Event.
8. **Fitness to Participate:** I declare that I am and must continue to be medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Event. I will immediately notify the Club in writing of any change to my fitness and ability to participate. I understand and accept that the Club will continue to rely upon this declaration as evidence of my fitness and ability to participate.
9. **Consent to medical treatment:** If required, the Club will arrange medical or hospital treatment (including ambulance transportation) for me. I authorise such actions being taken by the Club where my further consent cannot be obtained and agree to meet all costs associated with such action.
10. **Privacy:** I understand that the information I have provided is necessary for the conduct of the Event and for the Objects of the Club. I acknowledge and agree that the information will only be used by the Club to facilitate the conduct of the Event and other events conducted by the Club. I understand that I will be able to access my information through the Club. If the information is not provided my Event entry application may be rejected.
11. **Copyright and right to use image:** I acknowledge and consent to photographs being taken of me during my participation in the Event and authorise the Club to use such photographs for promotional or other purposes without my further consent being obtained. Further, I consent to the Club using my name, image, likeness and also my performance in the Event, at any time, to promote the Event or Club activities by any form of media.
12. **Severance:** If any provision of this declaration is invalid or unenforceable in any jurisdiction, the phrase or clause is to be read down for the purpose of that jurisdiction, if possible, so as to be valid and enforceable. If the phrase or clause cannot be so read down it will be severed to the extent of the invalidity or unenforceability. Such severance does not affect the remaining provisions of this membership declaration or affect the validity or enforceability of it in any other jurisdiction.
13. I warrant that my boat complies with the safety prescriptions of Yachting Australia Inc and Yachting Victoria Inc. and that it my responsibility to ensure all equipment required under these prescriptions and my declared safety category are operational at all times.

I have read, understood, acknowledge and agree to the above declaration including the warning, exclusion of implied terms, release and indemnity. I warrant that all information provided in my Event application is true and correct. I acknowledge that this Event application declaration cannot be amended. If I do amend it my application will be null and void.
